1. It's what FUN is. It's also where you can visit a pioneer era jail and ride a wooden carousel that is 130 yrs old. Your photo can be of anywhere outside or inside the park, or include any signs or rides. It just needs to show you know the answer to the clue.



2. Once thought to be pioneer era artillery, this object was later discovered to be a Civil War munition. It was donated to the city by the Daughters of the Utah Pioneers in the 1940's.



3. This monument was constructed in 1948 to celebrate the 100 year anniversary of the settlement of Ezra T. Clark's Family in Farmington. The Clarks were one of the original founding pioneers of Farmington and our Clark Lane Historical District is named for them.



4. In 1878 the very first Primary
Meeting for the Church of Jesus
Christ of Latter-Day Saints was held
here. It was organized by one of the
city's pioneers, Aurelia Spencer
Rogers. A mural inside the building
commemorates this important
event.



5. This home was built by a 19 yr old, Walter Grover for his mom in 1880. Originally it was a 2-bedroom rock home, but over the years there have been additions added on to it. A historical marker can be found on the road telling its history.



6. This building was originally a Tithing Office. It then was used as Farmington's City Hall. Nowadays you can visit this building to learn more about Farmington history.



7. Known as the "Father of Farmington", this is one of Hector Haight's homes. It was constructed in 1867 and features Farmington's historic rock architecture.



8. This home was built in 1895 by Joseph S. Clark and is located in the Clark Lane Historical District. It is a 2-story brick home. The original 2nd story was destroyed in a fire in the 1920s, but in the 1970's it was restored in period style.
