- A Water Distribution Operator Level 4 Certification
- One (1) year of construction, maintenance or repair of water distribution systems experience.

- You can help promote a positive attitude among department personnel and other contacts.
- You can assist in maintaining, constructing, and installing main lines, service lines, fire hydrants, meters, wells, valves, pressure regulators, pump stations, tanks, etc.
- You can operate various types of heavy, light, and complex equipment used in maintenance and construction of culinary water systems (i.e. ten-wheeler trucks, backhoes, excavators, high pressure machines, pipe threaders, hand tools, etc.).
- You can assist in monitoring city water well storage levels; assuring adequate water supply.
- You can assist in work zone safety procedures; flag on-coming vehicles to protect the public and workers; set up warning signs and signalization equipment.
- You can repair and install surface features damaged during system maintenance including landscaping, sprinklers, asphalt, concrete, etc.
- You can respond to customer inquiries, requests and complaints regarding maintenance, leaks, and flooding involving the City's drinking water systems and other related matters.
- You can utilize maps and records during emergency situations.
- You can conduct water sampling and monitor chlorine and fluoride levels.
- You can re-read residential and commercial water meters as needed to monitor customer water usage and perform repairs when needed.
- You have knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions.
- You have knowledge of blueprints and ability to perform basic mathematical computations.
- You can communicate effectively both orally and in writing; follow written and verbal instructions; establish effective working relationships with employees and the public.
