## Minutes of the September 25, 2023 meeting of the Historical Preservation Commission

In attendance were: David Petersen, David Barney, Shauna Waldrop, Kathy Cornejo, Darren DeGraw, Dorothy Arnold. There were no participants on Zoom.

- 1. David Barney shared the mayor's letter in support of the Buttered Bake Shop receiving a T-Mobile grant. We have five letters of support for this project.
- 2. The City Council tabled the vote on the nomination of the Main Street Historic District for the Farmington Landmarks register. They want to see a couple of issues addressed, but a vote will be taken at the next City Council meeting. The changes to the ordinances were voted on. It was moved and seconded that the changes to the landmarks register be accepted and the vote was unanimous. The Historical Commission members are encouraged to attend the City Council meeting in November, when the vote on the addition of the Main Street District to the landmarks register is on the agenda.
  - 3. MPS (Theme 1800s) New Historic District was approved as is.
  - 4. All eight of the new homes that were proposed for the new district were deemed qualified.
- 5. We don't know if the historic documentation and photos from Tom Owens have been added to the museum.
