Nomination of six historic homes to the MPS (Them 1800s) - Status

- Sherry has finished all research including suggestions made by Cory Jensen from the State.
- The May and September State meetings are both full and the homeowners will need to wait until January 2025 to know if their homes are approved.

Nomination of the Main Street Historic District to the Farmington Landmarks Register - Status

- City council wanted to review this district with the change to the Code Text Change proposal-Ch. 39
 - Approved A. Option 3
 - Approved B, Option I
- Next meeting with the City council will be May 7.

Farmington Historic Plaque Program - Status

- Kathy is working on a professional plaque flyer to pass out to homes.
 - Jody, with the city, will help make the flyer.
 - She already made the QR code.

Neal Sessions/Francisco Mexican building - New Photo and Status

- Estimate is 1.5 million
- Initial step is \$25,000 for the investigative work to remove metal siding to determine if repairs are feasible
 - Per Dave Petersen, this will happen ASAP
 - If approved, the city would want either a facade easement or conservation easement that would restrict the ability to change the outside.

April 22, 2024

- A conservation easement would restrict the ability of any future homeowners to change the facade.

UDOT I-15 Widening Section 106 Mitigation - Status

- Reconnaissance level survey for the properties that will be added to the Main Street Historic District.
 - Potentially 14 homes could qualify for this.
 - \$10,000 without the survey.
- Museum will receive \$8,000
 - Scanning
 - Transportation
 - Can upgrade current software to an online option
 - Unlimited number of users on search site.
