Subject: Property tax increase FY25, truth-in-taxation (TNT)

RECOMMENDATION(S)

- 1. Hold a public hearing on Tuesday, August 20, 2024
- 2. Consider and approve a resolution to formally adopt the certified tax rate

BACKGROUND

The fiscal year 2024-25 budget adopted June 2024 included revenue generated from a property tax increase. As part of the required process, the council must hear public input in a TNT hearing before formally adopting the certified tax rate of 0.001741 for property tax year 2024 (Farmington's FY25).

The tax increase proposed in the FY 2025 budget levies an increase of approximately 3.4% to a residence's total tax bill - or a 27% increase for Farmington City's portion of the property tax bill.

If approved, this property tax increase would generate approximately \$1,016,000, helping to cover the \$1,034,000 Police Department budget increase for FY 2025.

With this tax increase, Farmington would still rank in the bottom half of the county's cities for property tax.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE Farmington City

The Farmington City is proposing to increase its property tax revenue.

- The Farmington City tax on a \$724,000 residence would increase from \$503.32 to \$639.91, which is \$136.59 per year.
- The Farmington City tax on a \$724,000 business would increase from \$915.14 to \$1,163.47, which is \$248.33 per year.
- If the proposed budget is approved, Farmington City would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by 27.22% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding eligible new growth.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on the tax increase.




