- Vote for DETERIORATION BY NEGLECT re: Historic barn at 268 West State. Barn was built in 1899. We would like the barn to be rescued. An attorney consult is a good idea. Could it be moved? Could we partner with Lagoon for the project?
- 2. Update for DETERIORATION BY NEGLECT status of the property at 368 West State Street.
 - Andrew Clark is meeting with Dave Petersen. He does not dispute the designation. Now what to do about it.
- 3. Historic Plaque project: Shauna Wardrop reported that all existing orders have been completely researched except for three. one of the new ones was a re-application. Dana has four orders completed. One person requested a refund.
- 4. Neal Sessions/Francisco Restaurant building status. The sample opening will be recovered. Restoration looks possible. The rockwork will come off.
