ITEMS TO BE INCLUDED WITH THIS APPLICATION

- Description of the specific location of the discharge, display (Including diameter size), fallout radius, and spectator locations. Including perimeter security-control methods. (Required submittal - site plan)
- Provide a copy of the State of Utah Fire Marshal's office certified operator license who will discharge the display. This license must be current.
- Provide a certificate of insurance shall list Farmington City's project name or description of work to be covered.
- General liability limits of at least \$2,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence.
- General liability aggregate limit of at least \$4,000,000 if launching shells larger than 12 inches
- General liability insurance is occurrence based.
- General liability insurance limits apply to the project.
- Automobile liability \$2,000,000 combined single limit if autos are being used.
- Any Auto coverage is required if autos are used in the event.
- Farmington is named and listed as an additional insured on the vendor's policy (Copy of EOI provided to the City).
- A contract between the vendor and the City is put in place, and the contract has a Hold Harmless and Release from Liability clause indemnifying the City from any and all liability



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- General Liability and Auto Liability insurers have a current A.M. Best financial strength rating of no less than A:VII or equivalent.
- Provide documentation of Workers Compensation and Employer Liability Limits of \$1,000,000 per accident.
- Insurance is in effect (see dates on certificate) prior to awarding contract and during performance of work.
- Provide a plan for monitoring weather conditions, crowd control, and contingency plans for adverse or changing conditions.
- This permit application requires that a site inspection be conducted and permit released to applicant prior to any discharge. Security-control methods shall be in place prior to setup of pyrotechnic display.
- NFPA 1123 is followed and complied with as listed above

General Liability Endorsements Required (*attach hard copy to certificate*)

- ☐ Farmington City, its officers, officials, employees, volunteers and agents are to be covered as additional insureds with respect to liability, including defense costs, arising from this project.
- ☐ Coverage shall be primary as respects the City. Any insurance or self-insurance maintained by Farmington City, its officers, officials, employees, volunteers or agents shall be excess and not contribute with it.

This permit application along with the above information shall be submitted to Farmington City Fire Department no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the planned event that the display/special effects fireworks will be used. Governmental subdivisions and governmental entities are exempt from the permit fee requirements of this Section, however, the application must be timely submitted and the proper permit obtained prior to the planned discharge of display or special effects fireworks.
