The Farmington Fire Department is committed to protecting life, property, and the unique character of our city. As our community continues to grow, so does the need to maintain strong emergency response capabilities, modern fire prevention practices, and consistent safety oversight for homes, businesses, and public spaces.

To support these goals, updated Fire Department fees—as adopted in the Farmington City Consolidated Fee Schedule on October 7, 2025—will go into effect on January 1, 2026. These fees help ensure that fire inspections, plan reviews, safety permits, and other prevention services are delivered efficiently and fairly, without shifting the cost burden to taxpayers who do not use these services.

These updates focus on maintaining code compliance, supporting responsible development, and providing the resources needed to keep our firefighters equipped and ready. Day-to-day fire and EMS services to our residents are not affected by this change, and emergency response remains funded and available to all who call for help.

We encourage business owners, contractors, and residents who work with permits, inspections, or fire protection systems to review the updated fee information. The complete schedule is available through Farmington City, and our staff is happy to answer questions or help you navigate any upcoming projects.
